Rules:

The BBP will be awarding a minimum of (2) - \$1000 cash scholarships.

Eligible applicants:

- Graduating senior from any Chautauqua County public, private, parochial or home-school.
- Must exhibit excellence in an eligible cultural art form-Music, Dance, Theatre or Visual Arts.
- Must intend to enroll full-time in an accredited college, university, or institution of formal education in the fall of 2017 to pursue continued training in the respective art discipline.
- Must possess strong personal character
- Winners must provide proof of enrollment by submitting final bill from institution. Award will be paid directly to the institution.
- This is a one-time award for high school seniors only.
- Application and Letter of recommendation must all be postmarked by deadline listed in packet.
- Winners will be announced during the BBP Symphony Finale.
- Applicants are encouraged to be present but not required.
